- Open to residents with total household income of \$70,000 or less
- All upgrades are free to the homeowner
- Upgrades include air-sealing, insulation, ductless heat pumps (heating + AC), lowcost energy savings products
- 22,000 registrations and 5000 homeowners through the program in first year


Eddie received \$7,300 worth of spray foam insulation in his basement workshop at zero cost to him through the Enhanced Energy Savings Program.

"I can now work comfortably in my workshop every day, even on bitterly cold days...there weren't many days this winter where I wasn't down in the basement some."











